

CENTRAL MESSAGE OF THE SCRIPTURES

The center and shortest chapter in the Scriptures is Psalm 117 (2 verses).

PSALM 117:1-2:

Praise YHWH (the Lord), all you nations: praise Him, all you people. For His merciful kindness is great towards us: and the truth of YHWH (the Lord) endures forever. Praise YHWH (the Lord).

The longest chapter in the Scriptures is Psalm 119 (176 verses).

There are 594 chapters before Psalm 117 and 594 chapters after Psalm 117.

$$594 + 594 = 1188$$

Psalm 118:8 is located between the shortest chapter of the Scriptures, (Psalm 117), and the longest chapter of the Scriptures (Psalm 119).

PSALM 118:8:

It is better to trust in YHWH (the Lord) than to put confidence in man.
